

## ICATT & ACCA renew Joint Scheme Arrangement for five year term

The Institute of Chartered Accountants of Trinidad & Tobago (ICATT) recently renewed its Joint Scheme Agreement with the Association of Certified Chartered Accountants (ACCA) for another five (5) year term in June 2010. This agreement positions ICATT as the local administrator of ACCA's educational programmes and examinations in Trinidad and Tobago for its Professional and Technician students numbering approximately seven thousand (7000) students.

The agreement was signed between ACCA's recently appointed Regional Director- Europe and Americas, Roger Acton and ICATT's President, Anthony Pierre who said that, "This agreement renews ICATT's

commitment to developing the future generation of accountants in Trinidad and Tobago. The ACCA designation is a global brand that can only mean positive things for the bearer and the Institute remains steadfast in its objective of producing qualified, ethical all - round accountants."

Roger Acton added "I am delighted to sign the Joint Examination Scheme Agreement which represents an important component of ACCA's pledge to strengthening National Institutes and as such supporting the development of the accounting profession in the region. We have eighteen (18) JES partners around the world, including five (5) in the Caribbean, through which we are able to provide wider access to ACCA's globally-accepted qualifications."
